Policy exclusions

- Repair of external ear lobes will not be routinely commissioned by the ICB for cosmetic reasons.
- Repair of external ear lobes as a result of a gauge piercing is excluded from treatment by the ICB.

Policy inclusion criteria

This procedure is only commissioned by the ICB for the repair of totally split earlobes as a result of direct trauma.

An enhancement for people living in Leeds as the policy currently in place in that area states a limit of 2 years after experiencing the trauma for the ear lobe repair to be done. This limit is removed entirely in line with the other places in West Yorkshire.
