LA	05/06/18	Complete: NHS England has agreed to support increased funding to support the commissioning of primary care capacity to improve access to dental services. The funding, comprising of both recurrent and non-recurrent funding, is initially up to £5m of the dental allocation. A range of criteria was agreed for the allocation of that funding and include the lowest overall ranking based on Unit of Dental Activity (UDA) per head of population, deprivation and percentage of the population accessing a dentist.			

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45/18 (cont)				8 constituencies (Bradford South and East, Calder Valley, Hemsworth, Dewsbury, Morley and Outwood, Leeds North West and Colne Valley) have been identified as sitting below the average commissioned position and will therefore receive funding totalling approx. £1.8M allocated according to need. General Dental Practices in those areas have been offered the opportunity to deliver additional capacity over a 3 year period – this will enable approx. 16,000 new patients to have a regular dentist. The contractual elements are being put in place so appointments for patients will be available in mid-June 2018.
